TMNP is an innovative endeavour to integrate the vision of two great leaders and philosopher of India. These philosophers are **Mahatma Gandhi** and **Swami Vivekananda**. Mahatma Gandhi emphasis on the self-sustaining village and Swami Vivekananda stress on dedicated youth at the grass-root level to make India independent in true sense. Thus, both emphasised on grass-root community mentors and leaders. The project attempts to achieve the same.

Lacks of attention towards the large population of students from an underprivileged community, who are or might be gifted go unseen. They are not honed and accept a lifeless privileged. Nurturing such children is the direct contribution in empowering in the grass-root level and gaining more acceptances with the community, also making villages and tribes to be self-dependent rather than seek out to the cities for empowerment. The TMNP is designed to establish a system where such potential mentors and leaders are identified from underprivileged community at a young age and nurtured. Such nurtured leaders and mentor will be able to lead their community to a progressed society.

The value of the identification and development of these underprivileged gifted children truly can't be overstated; from an invisible status, girls, as well as boys, are nurtured in order to allow them to recognize their potential, develop their abilities, and dedicate themselves to further education—and most importantly, to giving back to their communities. While TMNP reports very modest numbers of those served directly through the Tribal Mensa Nurturing Program (TMNP), the effects are expanding: testing and recommendations for programming (as well as the training of both educators and psychologists) has expanded to multiple sites across India; an effective partnership has established a program at many places.

About us: TMNP is a special interest group of Mensa India that works exclusively for underprivileged gifted. These high IQ gifted who have the potential to become grassroots leaders but are forced to spend their lives struggling to make ends meet.

Vision: To contribute to nation building through identifying, nurturing and empowering every underprivileged gifted child in India so that no gifted child is ignored in our country.

Mission: To establish a platform for underprivileged gifted children across India for developing and utilising their full potential.

Aim: To develop a self-sustaining system for nation building that identifies and nurtures underprivileged gifted children and provides a nourishing niche for their academic and economic empowerment.

The need to identify & Nurture Giftedness:

Giftedness denotes one's potential for becoming critically acclaimed performers or exemplary producers of ideas in spheres of activity that enhance the moral, physical, emotional, social, intellectual, or aesthetic life of humanity.

The key word here is potential-Being inherently smart isn't sufficient. Environmental factors play a significant role in the development of a gifted child, who needs support and guidance to achieve his or her gifted potential.



Identifying highly achieving children, either by school-marks or intelligence tests, is relatively straightforward, but for the unrecognised potentially gifted, the best way to help their abilities flower is to provide them with the educational means and the encouragement to take up the challenge. To reach a level of excellence in any area, children need the means to learn, which includes high-level tuition, consistent challenge and encouragement. **Prof. Joan Freeman**

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
Giftedness Enriched! (Annamaya Kosha): The active mind needs to be supported by a healthy body and a disciplined lifestyle. This phase imparts knowledge about our body and how to use various tools such as healthy diet, yoga, sports to develop fitness and stamina. This phase involves a lot of fun activities but helps the child identify with the principles behind following a certain culture, ritual or daily routine.

Giftedness Explored! (Pranamaya Kosha): Sharpening of the interpersonal skills, learning to use our senses individually and collectively helps the children to systematically organize their thoughts and develop a logical thought process. This makes them competitive and can act like a useful tool in study skill development

Giftedness Encompassed! (Manomaya Kosha): A Gifted mind plays a critical role in the expression of Giftedness. Extreme set of emotions, super sensitivity and all that coupled with a great imagination is a major strength, but if not addressed properly can lead to obstructions in performance. Importance of expressions and channelizing one's energies in the right direction is very essential for a Gifted child to stay in peace with oneself and the peers. This phase helps the Gifted child to gain control over his mind and emotions.

Giftedness Enhanced! (Vidnyanamaya Kosha): The vast knowledge that a Gifted processor accumulates has to undergo the right synthesis to be able to use it constructively. Various tools such as conceptual maps, brainstorming, enhancing scientific aptitude helps to develop this complex thinking patterns and problem solving skills. This help a Gifted child to perform better at studies and everyday activities. Just as developing the gifted potential is important, being able to convert the same into tangible achievements is equally important.

Giftedness Experienced! (Anandamaya Kosha): A Gifted student will constantly seek a purpose to his life. The urge to do something for others, ones community and nature helps the Gifted to achieve satisfaction. The Gifted child tries to define various criteria of his role model and tries to find the right guidance to help him or her establish the same in their lives. Our different projects such as 'Ecotours', 'Ecological Priest', 'Karthik Kridalaya' and 'Kher Library' help your child to bond with other Gifted Mentors and Mentees. By developing their own values and morals they are able to experience the happiness that they deserve.






Only 2% of Population are gifted

The first 4 Tribal Mensans were identified from Sevadham Ashramshala and since then TMNP has grown to nurture more than 3500 gifted students in the past 20 years. Through this project we endeavour to give back to the society not only in the form of education but also in the form of peripherals necessary for all the students living in the residential school such as Groceries, School Uniforms, Stationary, Sanitary napkins and other Utilities . This endeavour is aimed to make education a happy and a healthy experience for the body and mind. Such education will benefit the entire community and definitely bring up more leaders and pioneers to carry on the torch. Sevadham Ashramshala Trust is able to accept donations from outside India as well. TMNP fully endorses Sevadham Ashramshala and appeals to all of our well wishers to support us in this endeavour . TMNP is often asked “Why keep carrying out identification of more gifted students every year when we can’t see a tangible success story or output even in the underprivileged gifted students that have already been nurtured?” Tmnp decided to take up the challenge to answer this in a constructive manner. In order to do so , TMNP has developed a new pioneering, one of its kind program called **BHARATI PRAKALPA**.

Under the aegis of this program, the underprivileged girls who have already undergone nurturing for three years undergo an entirely different, customised nurturing. This nurturing begins with them committing 8 to 11 years to the program in terms of higher education, work experience ,and striving to achieve excellence in their career goals . The process of them defining their own career goals and life goals is facilitated by TMNP’s unique model of **‘Trigunatmak’**.

In this model, career goals and life goals of an underprivileged gifted girl are defined taking into consideration their interests , behaviour , personality and gifted characteristics . In addition they are also asked to articulate a statement of purpose for their model that elucidates their career and life goals briefly. They are then asked to create milestones based on future life events such as steps of higher education, resources required for pursuing life goals, family and social expectations and the path to ultimately achieve their life goal in terms of number of years that need to be invested as well as effort and qualifications needed to be attained. Once that is plotted, TMNP facilitates clarity in the milestones, gives the girls a reality check regarding their aspirations .TMNP also facilitates guidance and mentoring for each gifted girl in her area of education and interest. In addition, TMNP introduces them to a wider national and international network of gifted people and also provides them necessary work experience and help with their individual projects.

The expected outcome :

1) The student’s continue customized nurturing to help them progress into their field of choice and execute live projects or research, that will benefit their mother organization, their community and our nation.

2)This is a once in a lifetime opportunity for these girls, who have showcased great dedication, courage and commitment. They can be tomorrow’s success stories that validate how the non-academic, indigenous gifted nurturing program helps the gifted students to perform efficiently.

Current status: The girls have been working on their life goal setting based on the **Trigunatmak** model. The nature of these workshops has commenced in the form of interactions and discussions with TMNP mentors and facilitators.
