Subject: Explanation of exceeding the number of students in TMNP Vama Mahindra Project 2022-23.

Targeted Giftedness Screening: 1500

Completed Giftedness Screening: 2622

Dear Sir,

TMNP's Gifted Identification, i.e., TMNP Shodh, is an unbiased process. We conduct testing for all students, irrespective of gender. So, the number of students in the 8th, 9th and 10th grades are tested. With this logic In 2022-23, we screened 2622 students from six schools.

Out of these 2622 students, 362 students (Boys and Girls) qualified for the Mensa India norm, i.e. scoring 95 and above percentile score. From these 362 students, we collected the Adhar card of 335 gifted students. We are trying to get the remaining 27 Aadhar cards.

Another important thing we follow in Giftedness Identification (TMNP Shodh) is screening Giftedness from Nov-Dec onwards of the previous financial year. This help to start the other giftedness phases, such as assessment and nurturing material distribution at the start of the academic year. Starting Giftedness Identification in the month of June will delay the entire process.
